

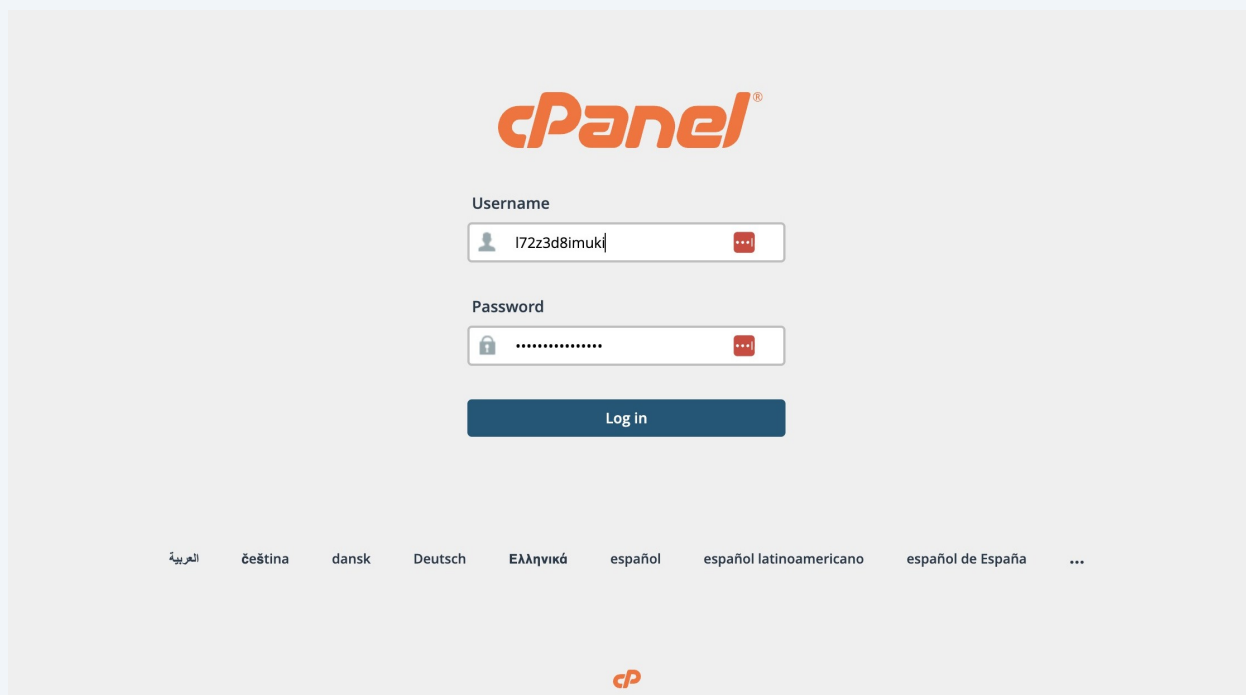
Managing Email Forwarders in cPanel

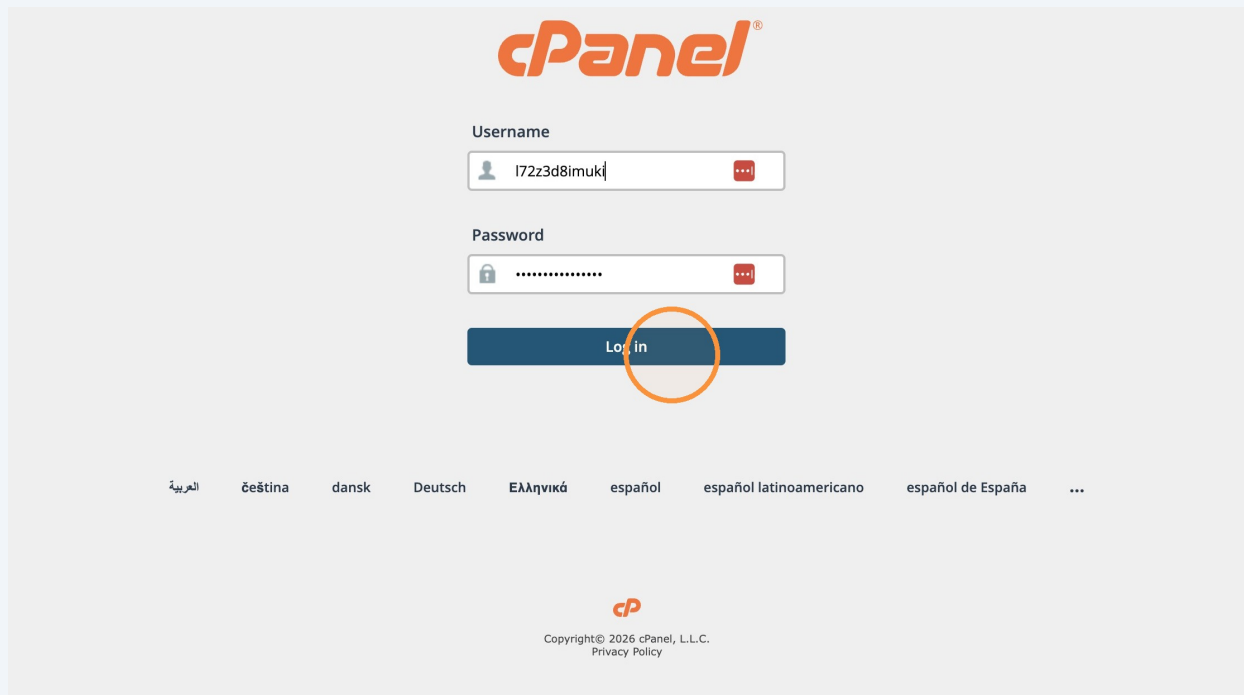

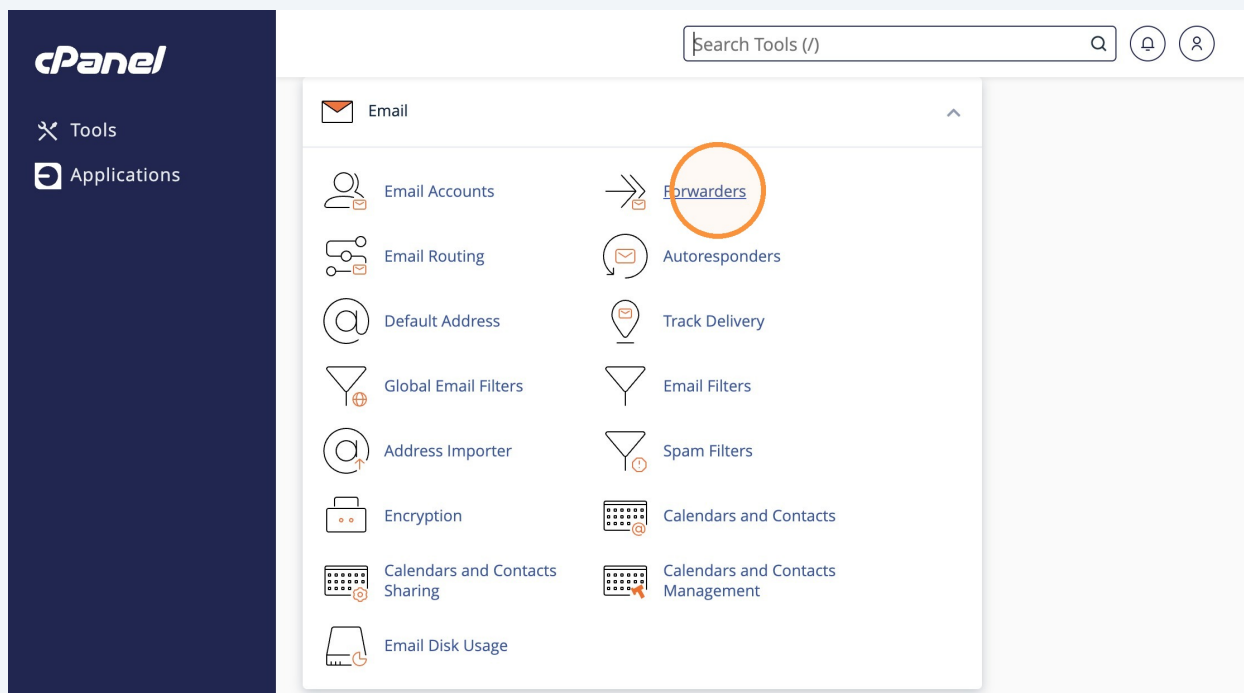

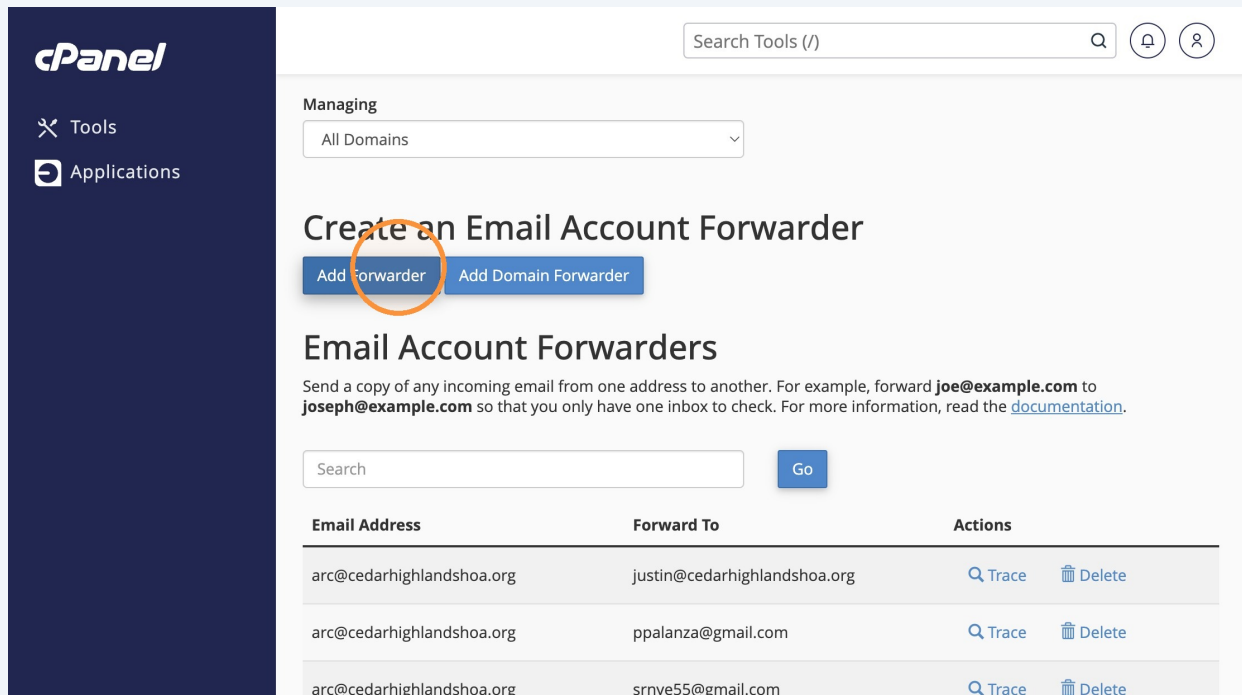
Forward All Email for a Domain

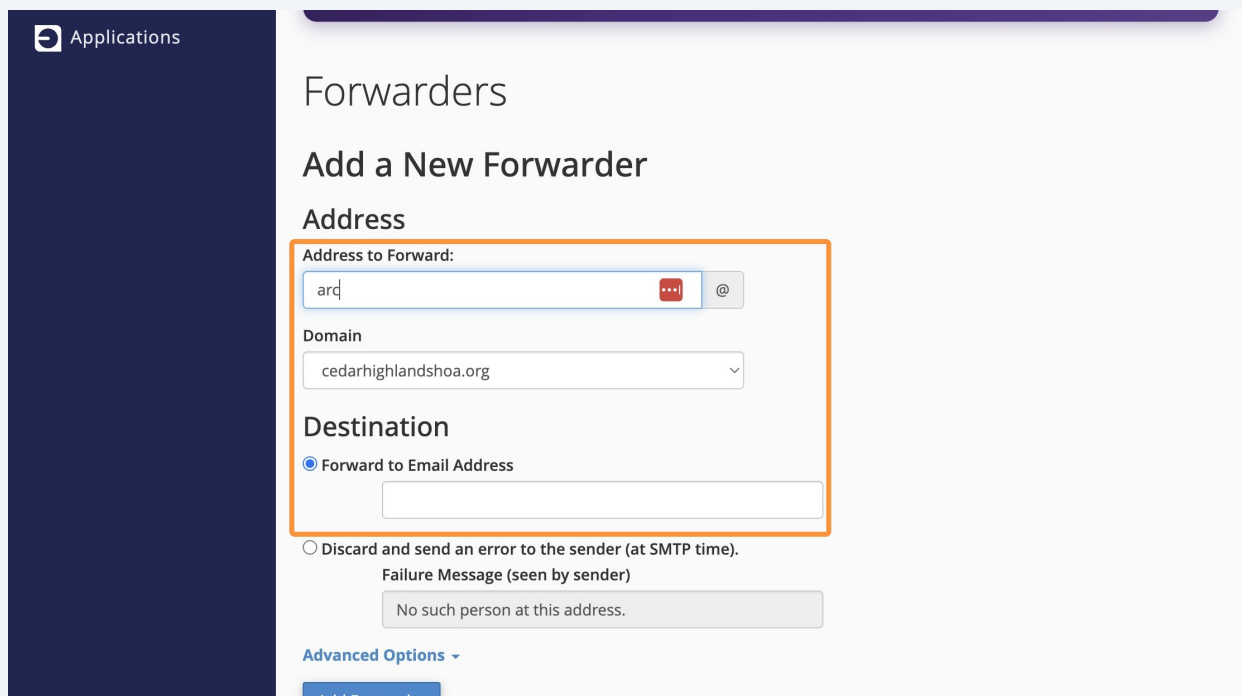
5 To create a new forwarder, click "Add Forwarder"

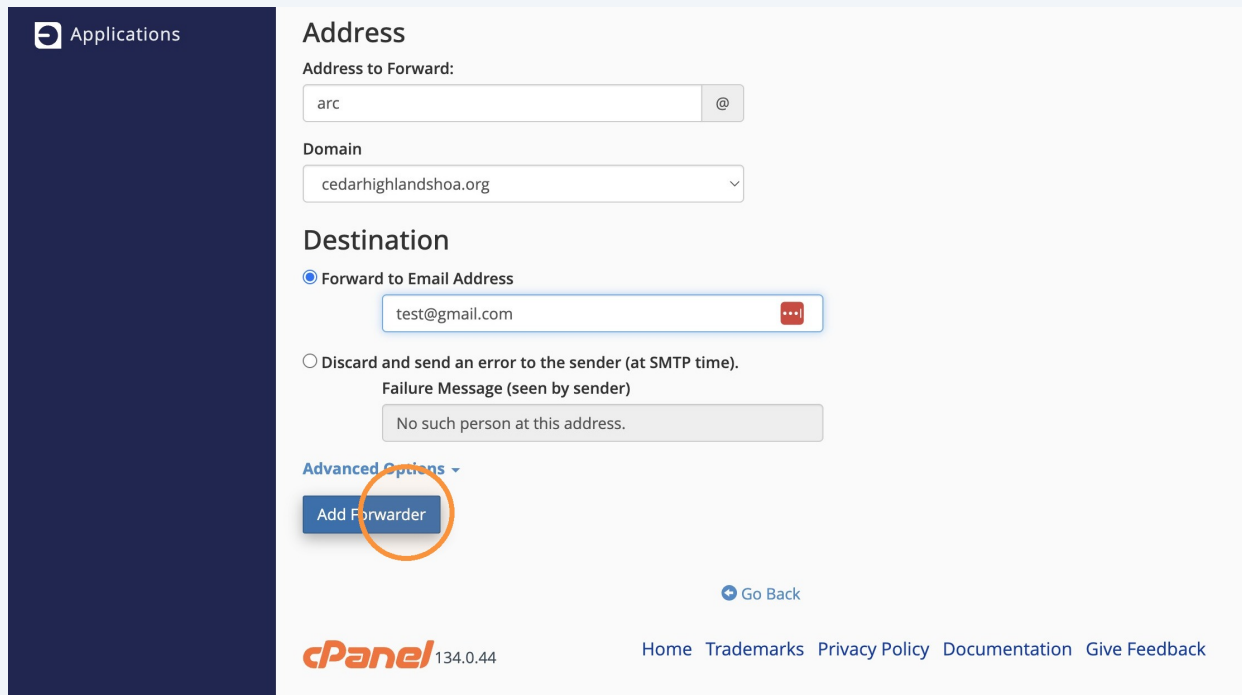

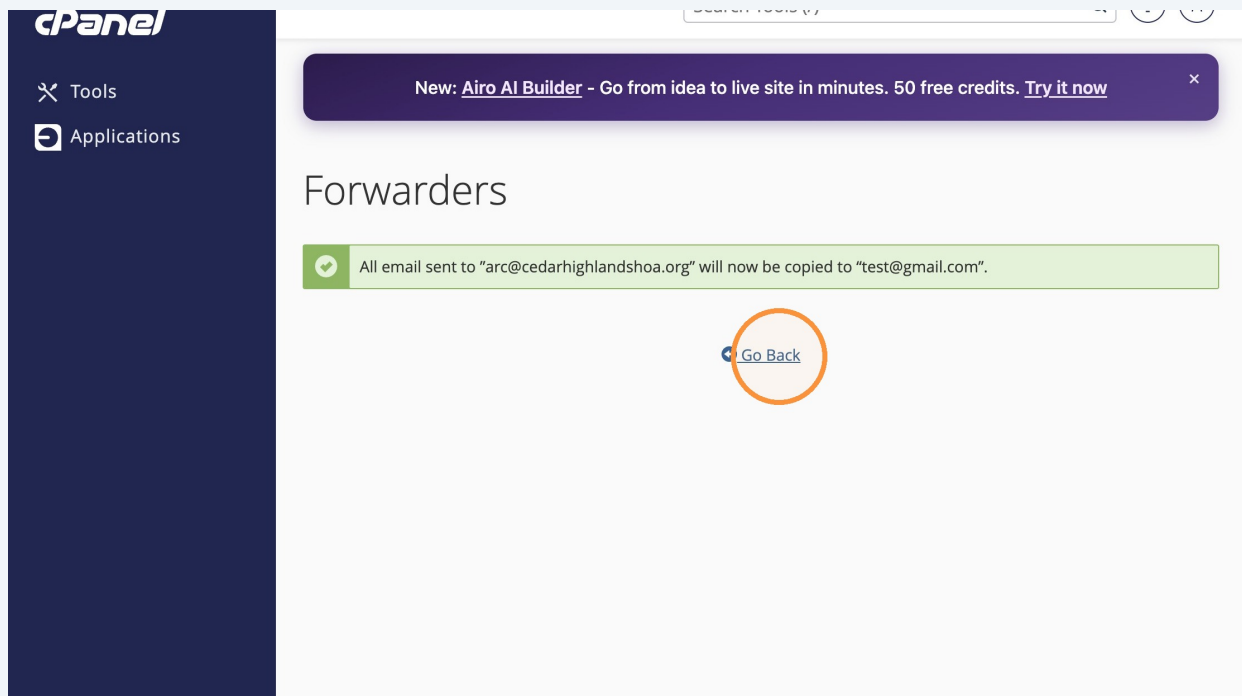

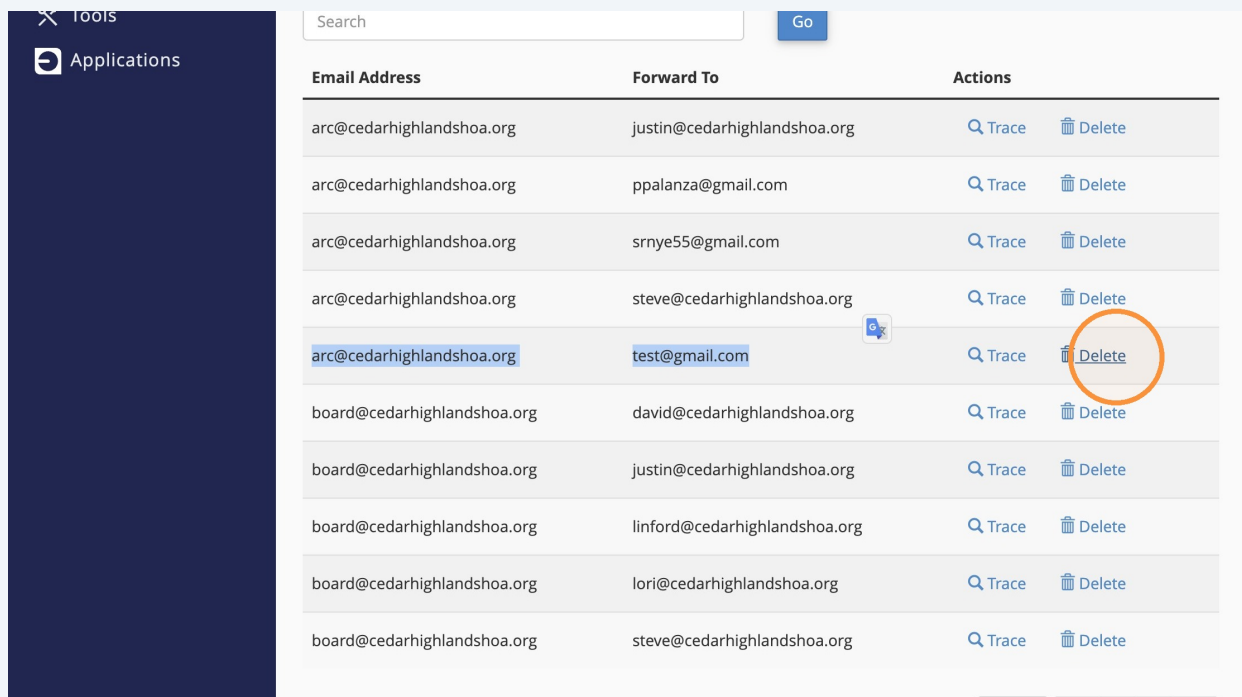

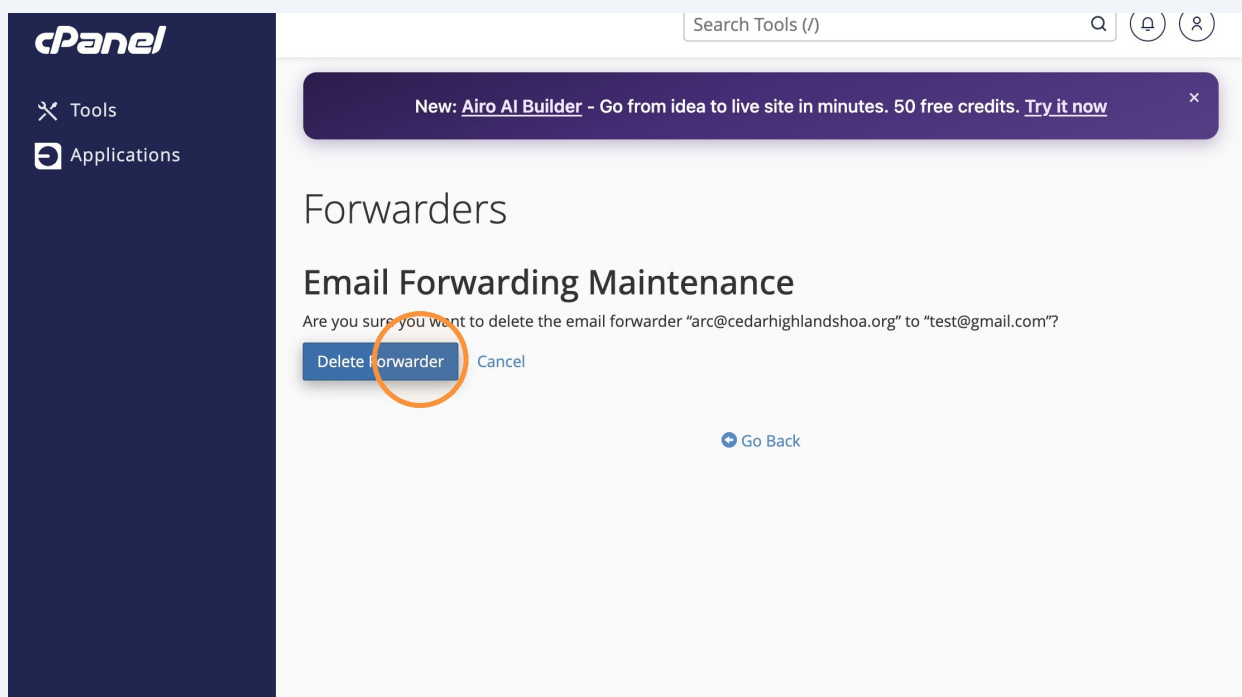
